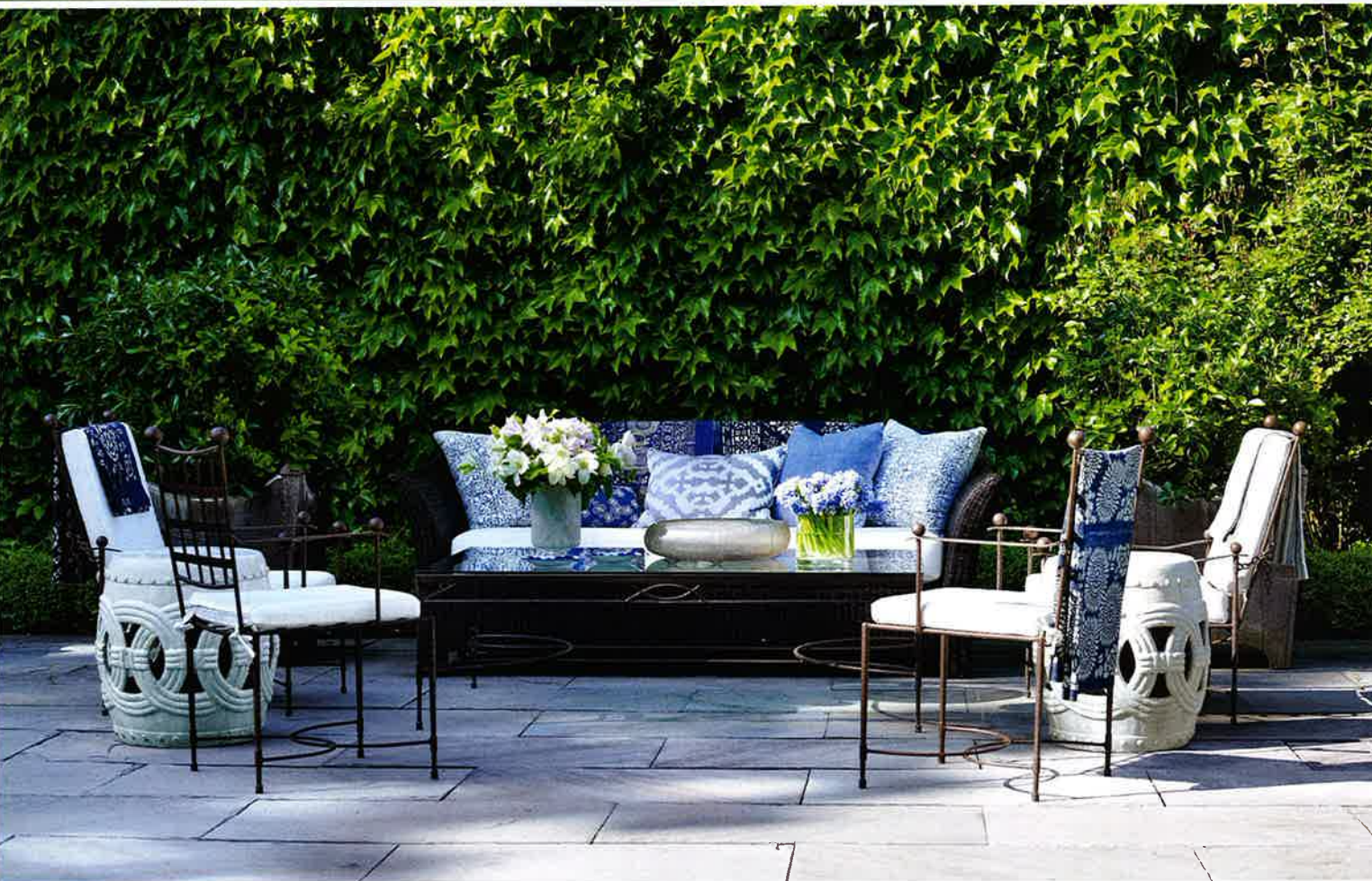
# TRIUMPH OF CHARACTER
