Inspired by its eponymous seaside locale in southern Spain, the Bolonia lounge's organic lines recall the waves of sand on that beach's namesake dune. Made from galvanized, epoxy polyester powdercoated steel, the piece is available in a variety of metal and industrial metal finishes and can be topped with outdoor cushions.

7 STUDIO TWIST

Brooklyn-based textile designer Scott Bodenner created the Breezeway collection of blankets, bed scarfs, throws and pillows. Showcasing patterns inspired by its namesake mid-century modern architectural element, the group is knitted with 100 percent polypropylene yarns that are colorfast, inherently flame retardant, machine washable and suitable for outdoor use.

8 JACLO

This outdoor shower column features a bottom water inlet for both hot and cold feeds. Its solid brass internal construction has a 0.5-in. female connection to facilitate outdoor installations. A polished stainless-steel finish accents the unit, which is topped off with a Rain Machine head and flanked by hot and cold valves.

Originally launched in 2015, the Tosca collection of braided outdoor furnishings—including this chaise lounge—recently added two new options: a Wenge finish for its all-weather cushioned fabric strapping material (shown), and a Piombo finish for its ceramic table tops.
