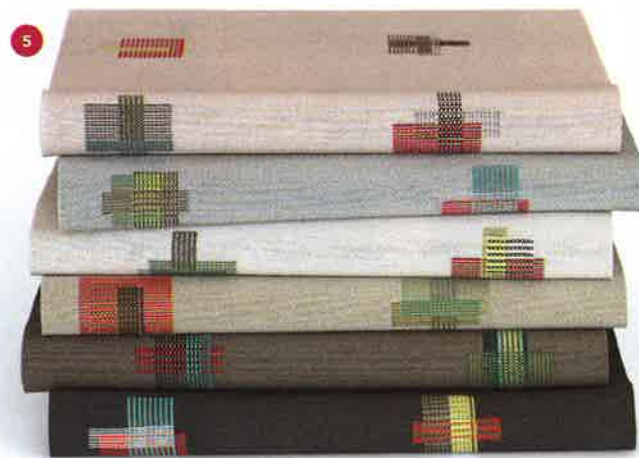
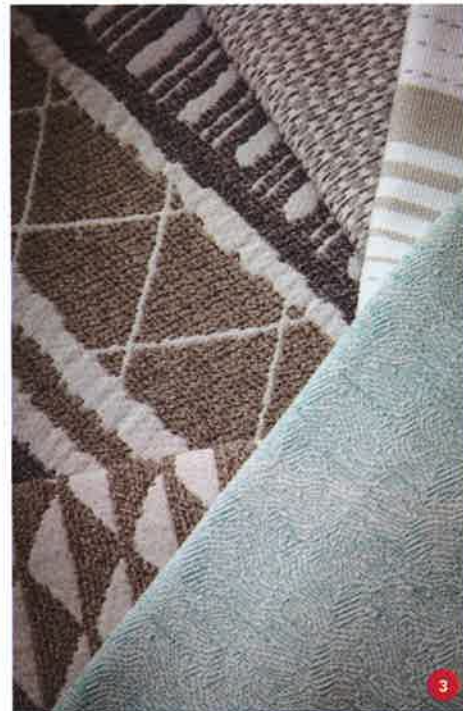
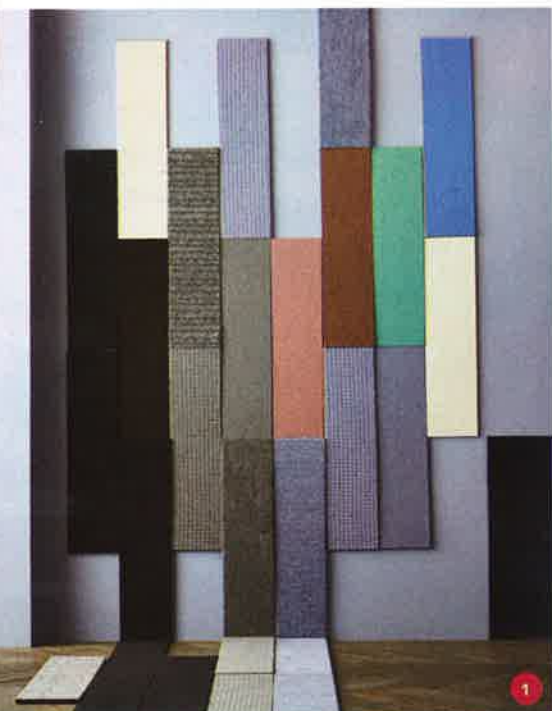

Made from 100% solution-dyed acrylic, the 3D (Design, Dimension and Durability) collection includes four patterns: Woolish, Daydream, Lofty and Crisscross. Fabrics are suitable for both indoor and outdoor use.

Textile chemist-turned-designer Laurie Jenkins created a fresh take on a traditional needlepoint embroidery method with Coral, part of the Laurie Bell collection. Made from 100% Sunbrella acrylic, this fabric line is available in wave aqua (shown) and anemone orange as well as custom colorway options.

Oceania is made up of 10 patterned textiles inspired by the Earth as seen from above. The upholstery and drapery collection includes designs such as Overland, a geometric-patterned weave made from 100% solution-dyed polyolefin.
