JANUS et Cie began as a single showroom at the Pacific Design Center in Los Angeles and now operates 19 showrooms throughout North America, Australia, Italy, and Singapore, with partnerships and collaborations from renowned designers such as **Patricia Urquiola**, **André Fu**, **Piero Lissoni**, and **Paola Navone**. The company's namesake—the Roman god Janus, whose two faces look both forward and back—is the perfect embodiment of their aesthetic, which marries a contemporary perspective with traditional techniques, such as handweaving. JANUS et Cie's captivating pieces, both custom and stocked, are just as suitable for residences as they are fine hotels.

The legendary **Belmond Mount Nelson Hotel** in the heart of Cape Town is just one of many resorts that feature exquisite furnishings from JANUS et Cie. Its veranda is adorned with the company's iconic *Arbor* side chairs with soft blush cushions that echo the hotel's signature pink hue, while the weathered teak dining tables pay homage to the resort's picturesque natural surroundings. Inspired by traditional Victorian garden furniture, the *Arbor* collection connects the hotel with its historical roots while creating a timeless space that embodies relaxed elegance.
