In the adjacent loggia (these pages), Zapatka designed steel columns with a nod to a bundled-reed motif found in ancient Rome. The wicker furniture is from JANUS et Cie.



A Persian carpet purchased by the husband in Morocco inspired the blues in the master suite (left), which is located in the addition; a tray ceiling inset with an oval recess is a Baroque flourish that Randolph celebrated with a Niermann Weeks chandelier and a pair of mirrors from David latesta. Zapatka's use of triple-glass panels in doors and windows throughout the house finds its grandest expression in the large spa/steam room (top) overlooking the surrounding forest.
