13. Facet from Innovations

Part of Innovations' new tactile collection, Facet evokes the meticulously hand-crafted surfaces of a bygone era. A rich juxtaposition of matte and metallic, the tessellation of natural wood veneers with a foil underlay has classic appeal with a Deco edge. The 36-inch wallcovering comes in a palette of nine colorways shot through with copper, gold and silver accents.

14. Gina Collection by Piero Lissoni from Janus et Cie

Janus et Cie introduces Gina, its first collection with architect and design icon Piero Lissoni. The collection mixes tactile materials and plush seating with practical durability and modern silhouettes. It includes modular pieces and lounge chairs engineered with a solid aluminum frame and woven rope seat, a chaise lounge that boasts an integrated surface, as well as side chairs and armchairs. 15. Oxford from Original BTC

Task lighting is an important element of an overall design scheme, illuminating functions and providing a sense of warmth and depth in a space. This was the intent for British lighting manufacturer Original BTC, when the brand expanded its Oxford collection, adding a table, pendant, floor and desk light to the collection's two existing wall lights. Each new light aims to softly illuminate the room, while also focusing a strong pool of light below.

16. The Harvest line from Landscape Forms and Loll Designs

The Harvest line offers a place to relax and share a meal, conversation or work. Created by Landscape Forms and Loll Designs, the table and bench top surfaces are made of 100-percent post-consumer plastic (primarily from recycled milk cartons) for a long, low-maintenance life. The metal legs and understructure are finished with Landscape Forms' propriety powdercoat material that resists fading and chipping.

17. Goleta Table Lamp from McGuire

The Goleta Table Lamp from McGuire draws on memories of summer evenings on the beaches of Southern California. A frosted milk glass shade extends from a frame of oil rubbed bronze and antique brass plated mild steel, like a paper lantern gently swaying in the breeze. The pull is sleeved with a post, which anchors into the glass shade.
