A MOUTHWATERING NEW BOOK FROM TWO FORCES OF NATURE.

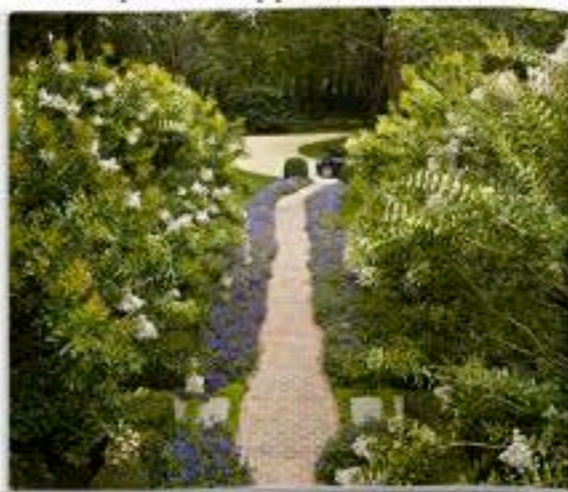
