Master Strokes

In the latest installment of her company's Masters Aluminum Series, Janus et Cie owner Janice Feldman has once again collaborated with San Francisco-based designer Orlando Diaz-Azcuy

to create a handsome collection of outdoor pieces that have all the delicacy and grace of furniture you would gladly deploy in the living room. Inflected with the genteel vibe of the Southern city for which it's named, the chairs and sofas in the new

Savannah line feature sensually curving arms and legs and pretty oval seat-back motifs set into a cane-like layer of mesh, all in a user-friendly scale that transforms powder-coated aluminum into a rarefied thing of beauty, readily available in 20 shades.



EMINENT ELEGANCE

Jan Showers's new collection for Kravet bears the Dallas-based designer's trademark, with feminine pieces in pale shades inspired by vintage French finds. 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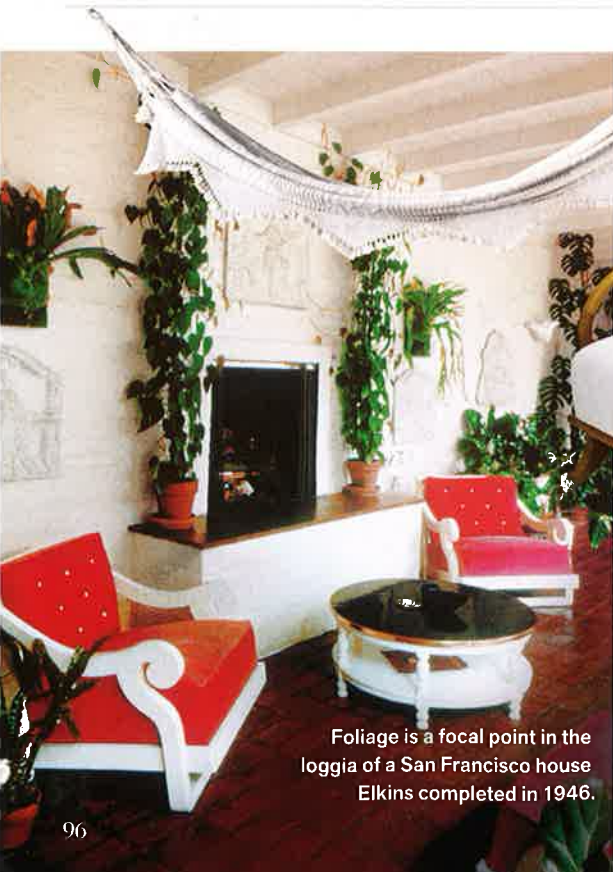

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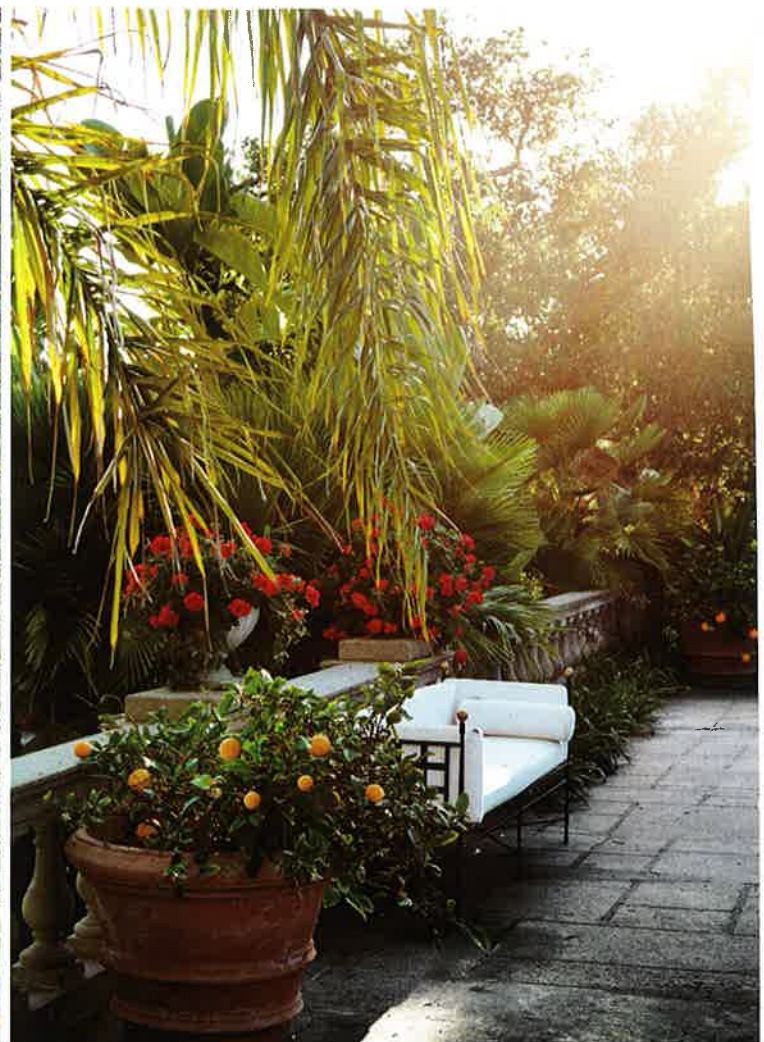


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Frances Elkins The prolific Elkins (1888–1953) collaborated often with her architect brother, David Adler. She was a classicist with a decidedly modernist streak, favoring strong, sensual lines and clean, clear palettes in well-edited interiors that relied on standout touches—a Giacometti sculpture, graphic philodendron leaves—for oomph.

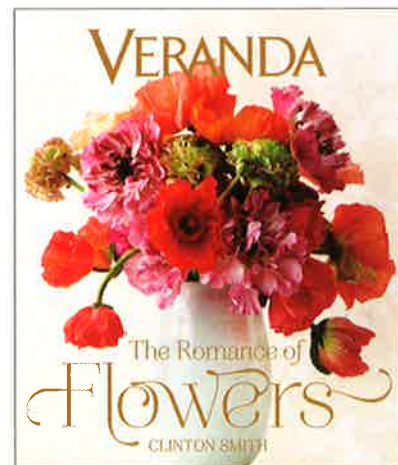
